Pre-Induction Activity

Activities to keep your French fresh:

1) Visit the EDUQAS website and work through the topic exercises:

then click on 'view resources' and then work through theme 1 (6 sections), then theme 2 (6 sections) etc...



2) Go through your GCSE notes and make a vocab list of words that are common or that you don't know- you'll need all the basic vocab from GCSE and more advanced words to help you at A level.



3) Read out loud your notes in French, or when doing a listening exercise, repeat out loud in French. You will be speaking French from the first lesson so you need to have French 'au bout de la langue' (at the tip of your tongue).



4) Go onto Youtube and do some research about the Present tense in French, so you have an idea about verb conjugations and more irregular verbs.
