MAKING MEDIA: CREATE A PODCAST, VIDEO OR ARTICLE



Following on from the activities you have completed, this Summer task will allow you to research and **make a simple and short media product** on an aspect of media you are passionate to talk about, whether that be relating film, television, radio, newspapers, magazines, advertising and or social media.

The task is simple, produce one of the following media products on an aspect of media that you love or are passionate about. This could be just about anything as media covers a wide range of genres, issues, topics and formats:

- **PRINT:** Write and design an approximately 500-word journalistic article, which includes images and follows the format of a piece of print or web-based media.
- **VIDEO:** Create a short video of 2-3 minutes in the style of a YouTube channel or video essay.
- **PODCAST:** Create a 3-4 minute podcast that follows the expected codes and conventions of similar products.

TOP TIPS:

Before making you're your media product, research and plan what you are going to say or do and think about some or all of the following:

- How **research** will inform the **messages and values** you want to communicate.
- Think about **technical elements** – eg: camerawork, editing, visual elements, sound and performance and how they will make meaning explicitly and implicitly.
- How will you use **language and tone** used to engage your audience? (eg: Formal or informal? Comedic or serious?)
- How will you **grab your audience's attention** at the start and throughout?
- How will the **layout/structure and use of visual elements** contribute to this?
